

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met September 21, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on September 16, 2010, with Steve Neujahr presiding, with Eugene Bergen, Kurt Bulgrin and Patricia Bredenkamp present. Also present at the meeting were Melanie Wilkinson, correspondent for the York News Times; Bill Sutter, County Attorney; Tom Shellington and Paul Buller. Commissioner Augustus M Brown Jr was absent.

The agenda of the meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and a copy of the agenda was made available to each Commissioner.

Neujahr announced that the open meetings law would be in effect and that a copy was posted outside the door and available on the table in the back of the room. Proof of publication was also available.

Moved by Bulgrin, seconded by Bergen to approve the minutes of the York County Board of Equalization proceedings of September 7, 2010; roll call: yeas, Bulgrin, Bergen, Bredenkamp and Neujahr; nays, none; Brown absent; motion carried.

Moved by Bulgrin, seconded by Bredenkamp to adopt the agenda for the September 21, 2010 Board of Equalization meeting; roll call: yeas, Bulgrin, Bredenkamp, Bergen and Neujahr; nays, none; Brown absent; motion carried.

Vice Chairman Neujahr read into the record a letter from the York County Assessor in response to a Notice of Appeal filed by the Monsanto Company with TERC - Tax Equalization Review Commission. This is only a notice; no action need be taken until an Order for Hearing and Notice of Hearing are received.

Two requests for Motor Vehicle Exemptions were filed.

York College requested an exemption on a 2003 Ford E350 van which is to be used to transport students for educational trips and extracurricular athletic events.

Moved by Bredenkamp, seconded by Bulgrin to approve the application for exemption on a 2003 Ford van for York College Vin #1FDWE35L43HA87578 for transportation of students; roll call: yeas, Bredenkamp, Bulgrin, Bergen and Neujahr; nays, none; Brown absent; motion carried.

A request was also received from Mosaic for a 2010 Chevrolet van to be used to carry passengers to and from church.

Moved by Bergen, seconded by Bulgrin to approve the exemption for the Mosaic, 2010 Chevrolet van Vin #1FDWE35L43HA87578; roll call: yeas, Bergen, Bulgrin, Bredenkamp and Neujahr; nays, none; motion carried.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 9:35 a.m. The next meeting will be October 5, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioners room, lower level of the Courthouse.
