

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met July 26, 2011 at 9:35 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on July 21, 2011, with Chairman, Kurt Bulgrin presiding with Pat Bredenkamp, Bill Bamesberger, Paul Buller and Tom Shellington.
