

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met November 7, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on November 2, 2011, with Chairman, Kurt Bulgrin presiding with Pat Bredenkamp, Bill Bamesberger, Paul Buller and Tom Shellington. Also present at the meeting was Melanie Wilkinson, correspondent for the York News Times.
