

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met on Tuesday, October 1, 2013 at 8:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on September 26, 2013 with Vice Chairman Bill Bamesberger presiding, with Tom Shellington, Jack Sikes and Paul Buller. Melanie Wilkinson, correspondent for the York News Times was also present along with Ann Charlton, County Assessor. Commissioner Kurt Bulgrin was absent.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda of the meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and a copy of the agenda was made available to each Commissioner.

Bamesberger announced that the open meetings law would be in effect and that a copy was posted outside the door and available on the table in the back of the room. Proof of publication was also available.

Moved by Shellington, seconded by Sikes to approve the minutes of the September 17, 2013, Board of Equalization meeting as presented; roll call: yeas, Shellington, Sikes, Buller and Bamesberger; nays, none; Bulgrin absent; motion carried.

Moved by Shellington, seconded by Sikes to adopt the agenda for the York County Board of Equalization meeting for Tuesday, October 1, 2013; roll call: yeas, Shellington, Sikes, Buller and Bamesberger; nays, none; Bulgrin absent; motion carried.

The Board reviewed the proposed levies which were set based upon the valuation and requests by the various entities.

Moved by Sikes, seconded by Shellington to adopt Resolution #13-54 setting the levies for the various political subdivisions within the county; roll call: yeas, Sikes, Shellington, Buller and Bamesberger; nays, none; Bulgrin absent; motion carried.

RESOLUTION #13-54

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of State Statute, governing budgets filed by all political subdivisions, it is the responsibility of the County Board of Equalization to determine the actual levy necessary to support a subdivision's budget request.

WHEREAS, each subdivision budget has been reviewed by the County Board as to the use of all available revenue sources, proper computations, etc. Accounting principles have been used and applied to the preparation of the final levies. The levies have been set by the use of the final valuation as certified by the County Assessor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio, the York County Board of Equalization, that the following levies be adopted:
